The ideal candidate will have a desire to connect with the South Bay community, have ability in planning and communication, have a desire to work with children experiencing homelessness, and be willing to work within a flexible schedule.

Responsibilities

Interns will be responsible for completing weekly administrative tasks, overseeing the distance learning objectives, completing education assignments as given by supervisor, and attending all required staff meetings.

- Overseeing daily academic objectives for the students
- Provide feedback and input to program coordinator for ongoing improvement
- Be a resource to the families as they partner in their student's learning
- Meet weekly with supervisor for feedback
